Data Releases

<u>New Collections</u>. We are please to announce the release of two new data collections (Total N = 70): Stanford University (PI Vinod Menon) and University of Miami (PI Lucina Uddin). Left-Right Orientation Error

Identified problem: Since last update, it has come to our attention that an error arose in the data preparation process for ABIDE-II_GU. This resulted in the orientation of the EPI being incorrect (i.e., left-right flip), relative to the T1 images, for 31 of the 126 subjects. We apologize for this occurrence.
